The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will conduct a Public Informational Workshop regarding the improvements for the above referenced project. The workshop will be conducted as both an in-person and a virtual workshop. The workshop will begin with a presentation followed by a question and answer period. ### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Widen the existing road from a two-lane undivided facility to a four-lane divided facility. The eastbound and westbound lanes will be separated by a raised landscaped median.
- Left turn lanes will be provided in the median to allow access to adjacent side streets, properties and businesses.
- Construct 7-foot buffered bike lanes on both sides of the roadway.
- Construct a 12-foot bike/pedestrian path along the south side of the project.
- Construct a pipe below the ground on the south side of the project to replace the existing roadside ditch.
- Install landscaping along the south side of the project.

### CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Construction will be completed in phases to minimize interruption to traffic.
- Construction activities will take place during daytime hours from Monday through Friday.
- One lane in each direction on Midway Road will remain open at all times and local access will be maintained.

### CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION

- Design Completion: Late 2021
- Construction Start Date: Summer 2025
- Anticipated Completion: Winter 2028
- Construction Cost Estimate: \$20.1 million
